During the Vietnam War, Vung Tau was home to the Australian Army and was a popular spot for R&R. The Long Tan Cross commemorates the Australian soldiers that lost their lives during the fierce battle between the Australian Army and Viet Cong forces.

DAY 1: SAIGON TO VUNG TAU

This morning you will be met at your Saigon hotel and transferred to Vung Tau. Later you will enjoy a city tour, visiting Bach Dinh and the Reclining Buddha. (L)

DAY 2: VUNG TAU – NUI DAT AND LONG TAN

See the former Australian army base of Nui Dat and the Long Tan Battlefield, where you will see the Long Tan Cross. (B,L)

DAY 3: VUNG TAU TO SAIGON

After check-out this morning you will be transferred back to your Saigon hotel where your arrangements end. (B)

DAY 1: ARRIVE SAIGON

Upon arrival at Saigon airport you will be met and transferred to your hotel. Enjoy a tour of the city this afternoon, visiting the Notre Dame Cathedral and the Central Post Office. Learn more about the American War in Vietnam with a visit to the emotional War Remnants Museum and the Reunification Palace.

DAY 2: SAIGON – NUI DAT AND LONG TAN

See the former Australian army base of Nui Dat. See the Long Tan Battlefield, Long Tan Cross, Long Phuoc Tunnel and Horse-Shoe Hill. Return to Saigon this afternoon. (B,L)

DAY 3: SAIGON – MEKONG DELTA TO HUE

Enjoy a morning tour of the 'Rice Basket of Vietnam', the Mekong Delta. Here you will see the former base of the 9th US Division and Riverine Units. Visit Ap Bac Village and cruise along the Mekong River's canals, stopping at tropical fruit orchards and craft villages along the way. After lunch return to Saigon and transfer to the airport for your flight to Hue. (B,L)

DAY 4: HUE – DMZ

Visit the sites around the Demilitarised Zone (DMZ), including the Rock Pile, Camp Carol, Tacon Airfields, Dakrong Bridge (now a suspension bridge) and Lang Vay Special Forces camp. After lunch visit Truong Son Cemetery, the McNamara Wall and Ben Hai River before heading back to Hue. (B,L)

DAY 5: HUE TO HOI AN

Embark on a tour around Hue this morning. Visit the Imperial Citadel and the Royal Tomb of Khai Dinh. Later, travel to the UNESCO World Heritage listed town of Hoi An, stopping at Camp Eagle and Marble Mountains en route. (B,L)

DAY 6: HOI AN TO PLEIKU

This morning you will be transferred to Danang airport for your flight to Pleiku. Later you will drive along Highway 14 to the Ham Rong Pass and Camp Enari, the former headquarters of the 4th Infantry Division. After lunch visit the Cacteka Plantation and the site of Bau Can. (B,L,D)

DAY 7: PLEIKU – DAK TO

Visit Dak To where you can witness how the ethnic Banar people live in their remote highland village. Continue to the small town of Kon Tum and stop at Camp Holloway, a helicopter base, on the way back to Pleiku. (B,L,D)

DAY 8: PLEIKU TO SAIGON – CU CHI

Fly to Saigon and travel to the amazing network of the Cu Chi Tunnels. Return to Saigon this afternoon. (B)

DAY 9: DEPART SAIGON

After check-out this morning you will be transferred to Saigon airport where your arrangements end. (B)
